Class Information Instruction is offered in charcoal, pencil, pen and ink, colored pencils, watercolors, pastels, oil pastels, acrylics, printmaking, mixed media, and for older students, oil painting. Weekly lessons are 90 minutes and held in seven-week sessions. The price per session is \$210.00. Students who wish to pay by semester (two sessions) will receive a \$10.00 discount. A onetime registration fee of \$5.00 is required for all new students. All supplies are included and only professional-grade materials are used. Students are automatically enrolled in the next session (or semester) and payment is due the first day of class. Please notify by phone or email at least one week prior if your child will not be attending the next session.

All students must call or email in advance to register and be placed in a class.

New students must pay in advance. Please include registration form, \$5 registration fee, and payment. See session/semester schedule for the school year schedule and session/semester prices.

Classes are offered Mondays, Tuesdays and Wednesdays. Thursdays may open up by demand.

Classes are approximately 3:15-4:45* p.m. (4th/5th elementary) and 5:00-6:30* p.m. (high/middle/college students)

Drop-off and pick-up times will vary. Special arrangements can be made for students needing an alternate time sc/hedule.

*Drop off and pick up times for class will be discussed and assigned during registration.

COVID POLICY

ALL STUDENTS PARTICIPATING IN ART CLASS, VACCINATED OR NOT, WILL BE REQUIRED TO WEAR A MASK PREFERABLY THE KN95 MASKS (THERE WILL BE A FEW EXTRA N THE STUDIO). STUDENTS MUST WASH AND SANITIZE THEIR HANDS ON ARRIVAL BEFORE HANDLING ANY OF THE ART SUPPLIES. DO NOT ATTEND IF YOU HAVE ANY SYMPTOMS OF A COLD OR HAVE BEEN EXPOSED TO ANYONE WHO HAS BEEN SICK WITH A FEVER OR ANY SYMPTOMS OF SICKNESS. STUDENTS MUST SIGN THE WAIVER TO ATTEND.

COVID-19 WAIVER, RELEASE, AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK FORM

On behalf of myself, my household members, and/or my minor child, I hereby give permission for myself or my child to participate in studio group art lessons with teacher Ginger Hawthorne/art is fun. I or my child are familiar with, and knowingly and voluntarily accept, any and all risks associated with participating in this extracurricular Educational activities. I acknowledge that I or my child's participation in this program is wholly voluntary and is not part of any regular school curriculum.

I SPECIFICALLY ASSUME ALL RISKS AND HAZARDS ASSOCIATED FOR MYSELF OR MY CHILD'S PARTICIPATION IN THIS GROUP ART LESSONS ACTIVITY INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, THE RISKS ASSOCIATED WITH THE NOVEL COVID-19 VIRUS. I UNDERSTAND THAT I OR MY CHILD WILL BE ASSOCIATING WITH THE TEACHER AND OTHER STUDENTS/CHILDREN AND MAY CONTRACT COVID-19, AND OTHER VIRUSES AND DISEASES, THROUGH MY OR MY CHILD'S PARTICIPATION. ALTHOUGH PARTICIPANTS AND TEACHER MAY HAVE THEIR TEMPERATURES TAKEN PRIOR TO PARTICIPATING IN CLASS THAT PRECAUTION IS NOT NEARLY ADEQUATE TO PREVENT THE SPREAD OF COVID-19 GIVEN, AMONG OTHER THINGS, THE RELATIVELY LONG INCUBATION PERIOD, AND THE FACT THAT MANY INFECTED PERSONS ARE ASYMPTOMATIC. I UNDERSTAND AND VOLUNTARILY ASSUME THE RISK THAT I OR MY CHILD MAY ACQUIRE COVID-19, AND THAT COVID-19 MAY SUBSEQUENTLY BE TRANSMITTED FROM MY CHILD TO ME, MY FAMILY, AND MEMBERS OF MY HOUSEHOLD.

While instruction and reasonable supervision will be provided, the teacher/art is fun cannot ensure my or my child's safety. Accidents and injuries happen, and it is impossible to eliminate the risk that I or my child will suffer an injury or illness.

I CERTIFY THAT I OR MY CHILD IS IN GOOD HEALTH, HAS NO FEVER, AND HAS NO CURRENT ISSUES THAT MAKE IT UNSAFE TO PARTICIPATE. I WILL NOTIFY THE TEACHER AND NOT PARTICIPATE OR SEND MY CHILD IF I OR MY CHILD DEVELOPS A FEVER OR ILLNESS OR TESTS POSITIVE FOR COVID-19. I ACKNOWLEDGE THAT I OR MY CHILD AND I ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR ENSURING THAT WE TAKES ANY NECESSARY MEDICATION, AND FOR AVOIDING ANY ALLERGIES. IN THE EVENT OF A MEDICAL EMERGENCY, 911 WILL BE CALLED AND I WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY AND ALL COSTS OF MEDICAL TREATMENT.

To the fullest extent permitted by Law, I hereby agree to waive, release, and discharge any and all claims, causes of action, damages, and rights of any kind against the teacher, (released party), the art lesson instruction business known as art is fun, its insurers, or volunteers arising from or relating in any way to any damage, injury, trauma, illness, loss, unwanted contact, harassment, disability, dismemberment, or death that may occur to me, or my child, or my household members—whatever the cause—due to my or my child's participation in this group art lesson activity. This includes, without limitation, any claim arising from the negligence of the Released Party. I further agree not to sue the Released Party and to defend and indemnify the Released Party for all claims, damages, losses, or expenses, including attorneys' fees, if a suit is filed concerning an injury, illness, or death to myself, or my child, or my household members resulting from participation in this group art lesson activity.

Parking and Directions to the Art Studio 2820 Guyana Dr., Richmond, VA 23233

Guyana Drive is located off of Church Road between Three Chopt Road and Pump Road in the Richmond's West End. From Church Road turn into Guyana Drive. (Guyana is closer to Three Chopt Rd. than Pump Rd.) 2820 is the fourth house (the white house) on the right. Please pull up and park in the driveway making two lanes so other cars may pull in. Please do NOT park on the street, stop in front of the driveway, or make u-turns in the middle of the street as we get complaints. During the summer, special parking instructions will be sent home for attending the Friday Art Shows and Pool Parties. When you arrive, please enter through the gate at the end of the driveway. The studio is in the back by the pool. Students will be dismissed at their designated time when they see your car arrive in the driveway, via our outside camera and television monitor in the studio.:)
